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Ana Jikia is a doctoral student at the Department of Art History and Theory, Faculty of Humanities, Ivane Javakhishvili Tbilisi State University. Her thesis is about Catholicos Zakaria Kvariani's Church building Activities in Imereti. Anna Jikia's research interests include monumental painting of the late Middle Ages and the XVII century Georgian wall painting.

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Nino Mgebrishvili enrolled at TSU Institute of Classical, Byzantine and Modern Greek Studies in 2003. In 2007 she continued her master's studies in Byzantine and Modern Greek Philology at the same institute, and since 2011 she has been a doctoral student in Byzantine and Modern Greek Philology. Since 2018, she has been a PhD student of Romance Literature, the Department of Romance Philology at Ivane Javakhishvili Tbilisi State University. Nino has participated in Erasmus + program and within the program scholarship, she studied at the University of Santiago de Compostela (Spain). The title of her dissertation is Literary Censorship and Mario Vargas Llosa's novel "The City and the Dogs".

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
